Procedures Regarding a Request to Remove Ineligible Dependents

In accordance with the policies for the Health Benefits Program (the Program) and the IRS regulation, when an employee fails to make a timely election to remove an ineligible dependent, the agency should request:

- an enrollment form to remove the ineligible dependent(s),
- supporting documentation, and
- a statement from the employee regarding the failure to remove the dependent(s) within the 60-day window.

The information and documentation should be forwarded to the Office of Health Benefits for review. OHB will:

- update the employee's health benefits record to remove the ineligible dependent(s) retroactive to the appropriate date,
- instruct the claims administrators to retract medical, behavior health and dental claims paid on the ineligible member(s),
- invoice the employee for any prescription drug claims paid since pharmacy claims are point-of-sale, and
- determine if the employee should be excluded from the Program for a period.

The IRS regulations do not allow a change in the pre-tax premium election outside of the enrollment window. The employee will be required to maintain the same membership level until the next Open Enrollment, or another qualifying mid-year event that is consistent with decreasing membership. The membership information will be updated in BES. **For the Cardinal agencies**, OHB will establish an unapproved "penalty" dependent on the employee's record to maintain the appropriate membership level. We will monitor this "penalty" dependent and update Cardinal when appropriate.
